There was a great representation of Florida athletes at the USA Junior Olympics. Here as follows: Symone Mason 100m placing 2nd-12. 06, 200m placing 2nd 23.87, Twanisha Terry 100m placing 7th-12.43, 200m placing 6th-25.02, Rafaela Gibbons 3000m placing 4th- 10:28.61.

At the World Youth Trials our Florida athletes were well represented: Lloydrica Cameron Discus placing 1st- 158-10, Shot Put placing 4th-49-06, Diamond Spaulding 100m placing 6th-12.24 200m placing 5th-23.99, Kendall Ellis 400m placing 8th-55.53
